In 2023, York Regional Police began working collaboratively with the Ontario Police College and the Ministry of the Solicitor General to improve our data validation procedures and transparency.










RACE IDENTITY BASED DATA

As of January 1, 2020, under the Anti-Racism Act, police services in Ontario have been mandated to collect data on the <u>perceived race</u> of individuals involved in use of force incidents. The 7 Race-Based categories include:

- White
- Black
- Middle Eastern
- East/South East Asian
- South Asian
- Latino
- Indigenous








SUBJECTS' RESIDENCY

Y

Significant increase in officers encountering armed subjects, with **68%** of encounters involving individuals who were armed. Over the past five years, incidents involving subjects armed with firearms have increased by **188%**.



Despite an increase of firearm encounters, YRP Use of Force incidents remain the lowest in the GTA. **92%** of Use of Force incidents resulted from citizen-generated calls.



Despite the evolving dynamics of modern policing, YRP continues to maintain one of the lowest use of force ratios in the province.



Training continues to enhance our capabilities in de-escalation, effective interaction with persons in crisis, officer decision-making, and the use of innovative policing technologies to improve public safety.
