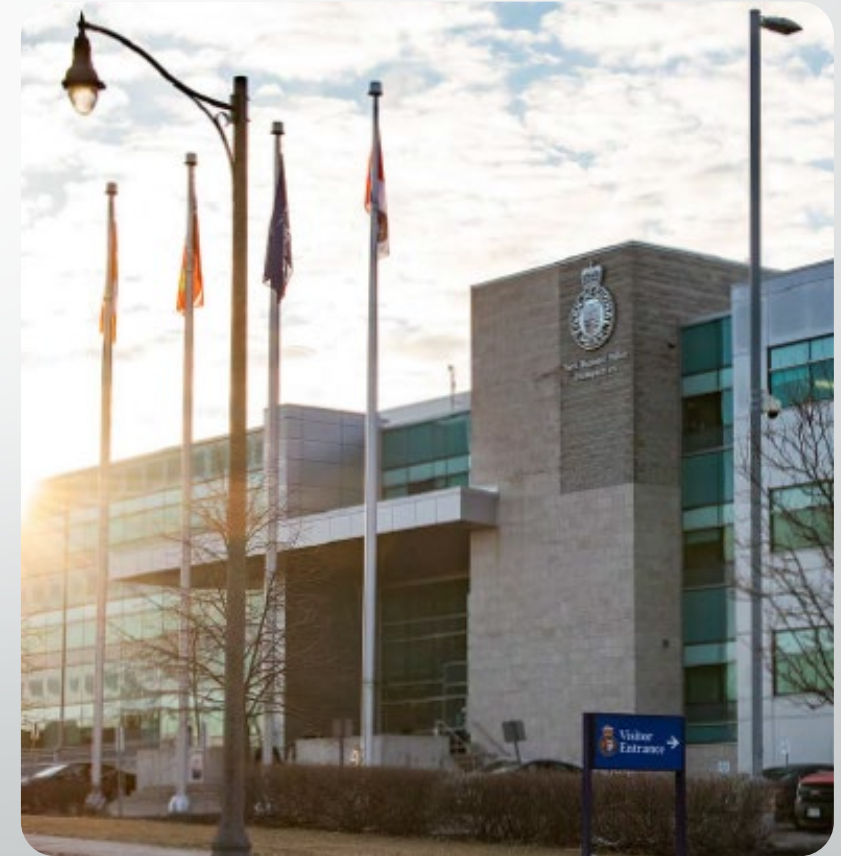

Aligned With Our Business Plan



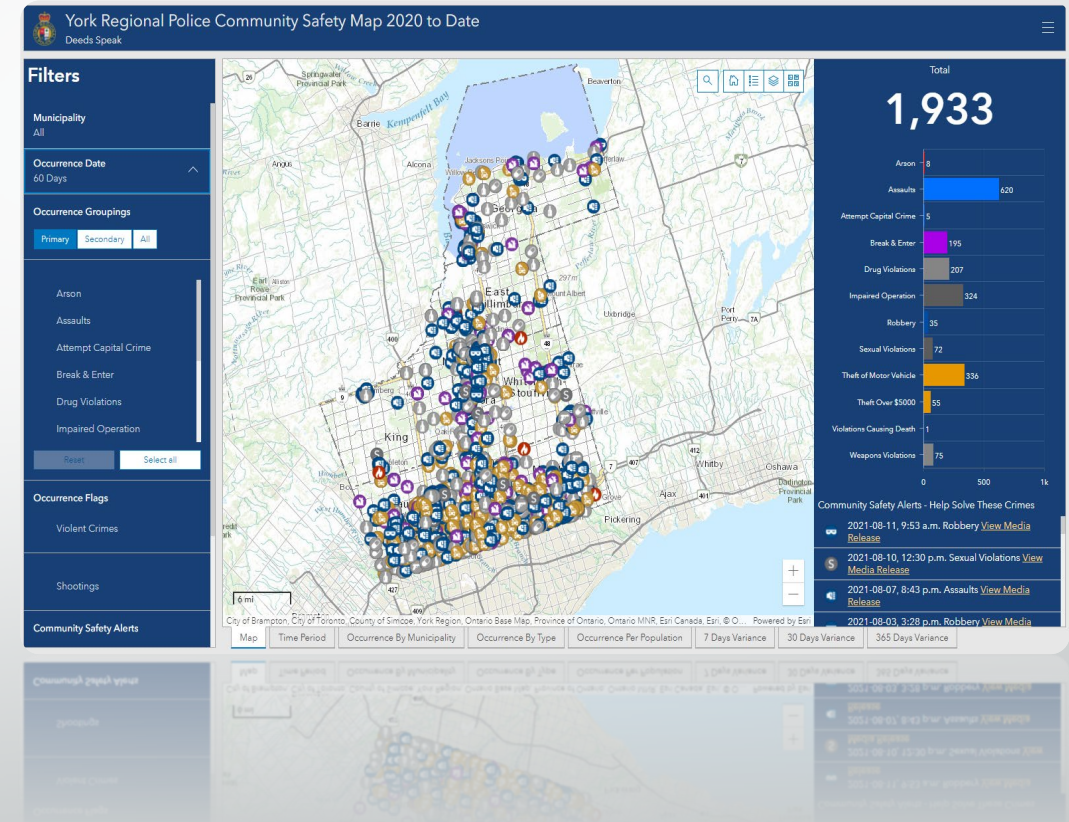
- Community Engagement:

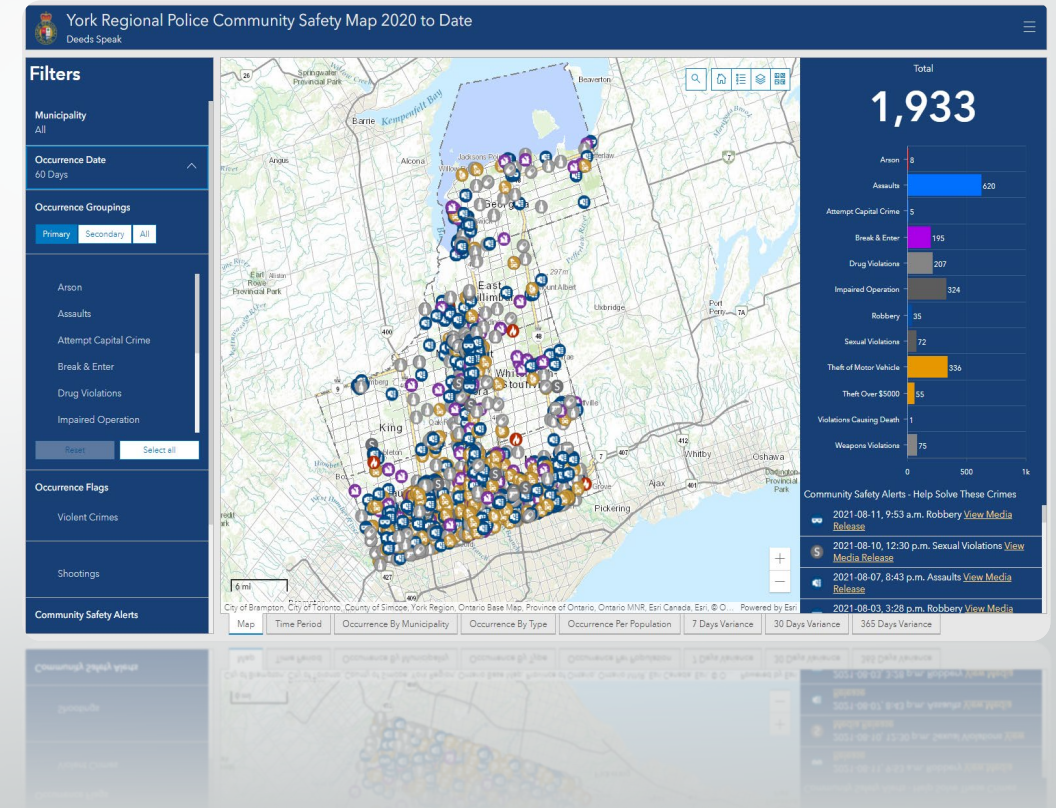

Phase 1 Priorities



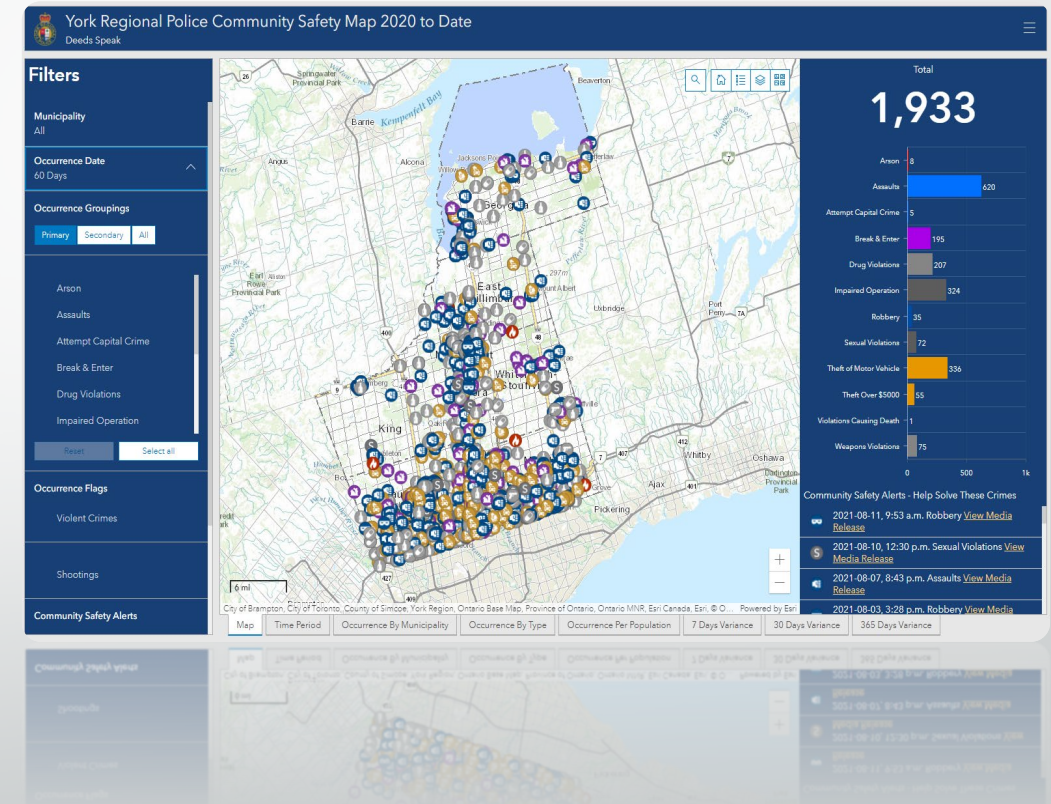
- Easy to understand crime data map

Phase 2 Considerations



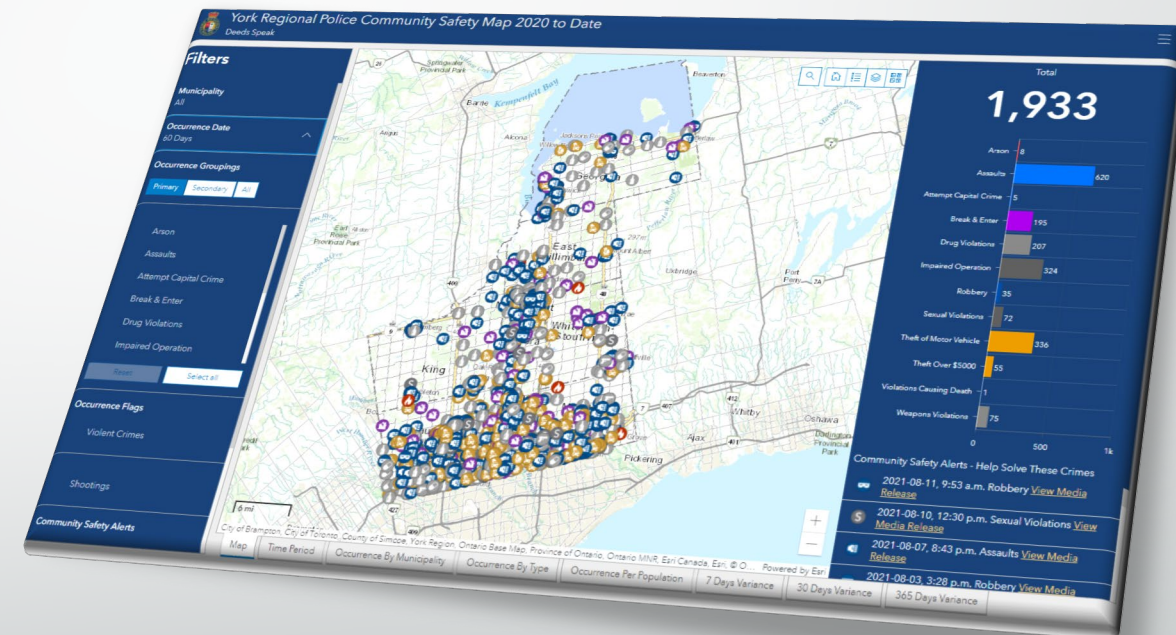
- Incorporate community feedback
