Report of the Chief of Police

Annual Report on the Disposal of Assets - 2021

1. Recommendation

That the Board receive this report for information in accordance with annual reporting requirements in the Purchasing Bylaw 10-17.

2. Summary

This report is to advise the Board of the disposal of surplus vehicles, equipment, parts, scrap metal, and other miscellaneous assets in 2021 totalling \$874,472.

Key Points:

- Purchasing Bylaw 10-17, Section 19 provides a process for the transfer, sale, disposal, or donation of surplus assets including an annual report
- Surplus Assets can be offered for sale by public auction or tender and sold to the highest bidder

3. Background

Purchasing Bylaw 10-17, Section 19 provides a process for the transfer, sale, disposal, or donation of surplus assets as follows:

- a) By transfer to the Region, a local Municipality or another Ontario police service for nominal consideration;
- b) Offered for sale by public auction or tender and sold to the highest bidder; or
- c) Donated to a not-for-profit or community agency for a charitable or benevolent purpose.

Reporting Requirements

A report shall be submitted annually to the Board to advise of the sale or disposition of surplus assets in accordance with Section 19 of Purchasing Bylaw 10-17.

5. Financial

Funds totalling \$774,100 were included in the 2021 Operating Budget for auction proceed revenues. These revenues are used to reduce the overall costs of policing to the taxpayer.

6. Conclusion

In 2021, York Regional Police received \$874,472 for the sale of assets, comprised of auction proceeds from vehicles, equipment, parts, scrap metal and other miscellaneous assets that was disposed all in accordance with Section 19 of Purchasing Bylaw 10-17. This report is being submitted based on reporting requirements.
