


Chart-A2.1 Total Crime Severity Index in National Comparators, 2020-2022




Chart-A2.2 Violent Crime Severity Index in National Comparators, 2020-2022




Chart-A2.3 Non-violent Crime Severity Index in National Comparators, 2020-2022




Chart-A2.4 Total Weighted Clearance Rate in National Comparators, 2020-2022




Chart-A2.5 Violent Weighted Clearance Rate in National Comparators, 2020-2022




Chart-A2.6 Non-violent Weighted Clearance Rate in National Comparators, 2020-2022
